A Message From Mark Smith

CHAIRMAN

It is with great pleasure that I write this year's annual letter.

In February we received a "Notice to Proceed" from Governor Kemp's Office. This notice was the culmination of 5 years of focused effort by our Authority, Staff, Local Delegation, County and City Leadership, Municipalities, Tourism Leadership Council, and Chamber of Commerce. It was a true team effort. It is amazing what we can do as a community when we all work together.

Of course, we could not have achieved our bold expansion plans without the support of Governor Deal, Lt. Governor Cagle, Speaker Ralston, Governor Kemp, Lt Governor Duncan, and the entire legislature for appropriating design money from 2016-2019.

A special thanks is owed to Governor Kemp, Speaker Ralston, Lt. Governor Duncan and the legislature for supporting the funding of the actual construction in the 2020 and 2021 bond packages.

We look forward to securing the final construction appropriation in the 2022 legislative session. This will complete the financing of our expansion at \$276 million. This brings the total investment in the Savannah Georgia Convention Center to \$498 million.

This is a remarkable community achievement. This is an extraordinary investment by the State of Georgia and Chatham County. This is an incredible validation of the strength of our convention and meetings business in Savannah, Chatham County. It is truly a growth industry. It is a success story.

We are now focused on bringing the project in on budget and on schedule. We broke ground in March. We have encountered some unexpected underground conditions but remain on schedule to open in Fall 2023.

We would like to thank our contractor Clark Construction, Pat Mathis Construction and our design team of Hansen and Associates and TVS Design for providing leadership and expertise for this most complicated project. We would also like to thank the Georgia State Financing and Investment Commission for their professional oversite.

Our vision of an expanded facility is being validated by the commitment of 20 events to date that will utilize the expansion. Many of these conventions would not have chosen Savannah if our Convention Center had not been expanded. The others are existing customers who will now keep their meetings in Savannah and host much larger conferences. It is so rewarding to see these bookings materialize. They will generate jobs and opportunity for all of the citizens of Chatham County and Southeast Georgia.

The Authority continues to engage with our designated hotel developers as we explore options for bringing more rooms to Hutchinson Island. We hope to formalize a deal next year.

We thank everyone for your loyal support to this institution. We look forward to the future with confident excitement!



















EXPANSION UPDATE


Since opening our doors in 2000, the Savannah Convention Center has been privileged to host a diverse collection of conferences and shows. However, in 2016, the need for more space to accommodate our customers' requests took front and center. In 2017, we received \$3 million dollars in funding from the Georgia General Assembly to begin design planning for an expansion. In 2018, an added award of \$6.3 million dollars continued the work of the design process and preconstruction tasks. In 2019, the legislature provided an added \$13.7 million dollars to continue the project and Governor Brian Kemp appointed the Savannah-Georgia Convention Center Board to oversee the SCC and its expansion. In 2020, an added funding of \$70 million dollars was approved to begin the first construction phase. In 2021, an added \$90 million dollars was allocated to the expansion. And on March 17th, 2021, a groundbreaking ceremony was held with Governor Brian Kemp, Chatham County Chairman Chester Ellis, Mayor Van Johnson, Chairman Mark Smith, General Manager Sherrie Spinks, and the Savannah Convention Center Board in attendance.



We have now entered an exciting phase in the expansion project. Every day progress can be seen on site. In August, the new route of egress and temporary stairs in the existing East Concourse were completed. This milestone allowed Clark Construction to begin the full demolition of the northeast corner of the existing building. Work is also currently underway relocating existing water, sanitary and utility lines to make way for the installation of underground plumbing for the new building. And Morris-Shea has to date installed more than half of the roughly 1500 pilings needed for the expansion.

Over the past twenty years, the Savannah Convention Center has an economic impact in Georgia of \$1.4 billion dollars. The expansion project alone is projected to add \$490 million dollars in economic impact, creating 600 direct construction jobs, hiring more than 30 Georgia based companies, supporting more than 3,200 jobs in Georgia and spurring the growth of new business locally and statewide. The expansion project will double the current size and capacity of the Savannah Convention Center enabling us to draw business from around the world. The local impact also cannot be overlooked. Expanding the Savannah Convention Center opens Savannah to more events, which means more visitors, more diners, more customers, more jobs, and more tax revenue.

Our careful and deliberate actions instilled confidence in our customers, and we finished the year having hosted 87 events with 60,644 attendees. One of these was The NAAA (National Agricultural Aviation

Association) whose successful event in December of 2020 resulted in a rebooking in 2021, as well as the Wings of Strength Savannah Bodybuilding show that has already been rebooked for 2022.

Weathering the challenges of this past year called on all of us to be flexible and work together. 
